WB4EHG took two action items to send: 1. some help for people having trouble with groups.io replies and 2. information about the CQ WW DX SSB Contest.

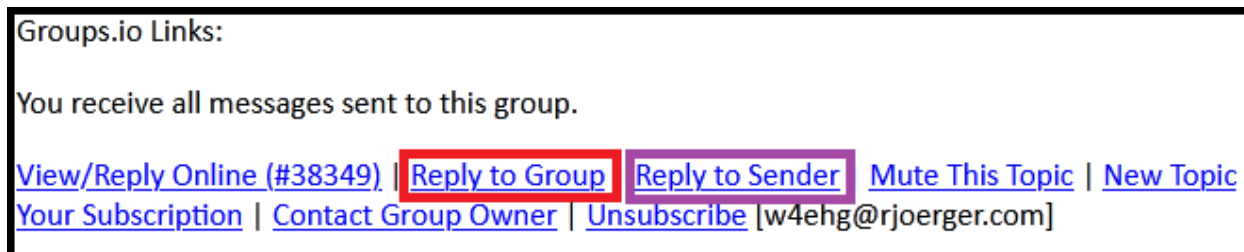

**Groups.io:** (simplifying: look at the highlighted sentences)

Members are having difficulty in replying to email on groups.io. I would love to have some simple way to tell you what to do but I can't find one.

1. It is easy to make a mistake and can be embarrassing when you expect a reply to go to Only the original poster but instead it goes to the whole group. (Ask how I know that)
2. What you see can be different depending on what email program you use IE Thunderbird, Outlook, your browser and what device you are using: your phone, tablet, pc. My phone is different than my pcs. It can be different in the same email client depending on how it is configured on your devices. Thunderbird is not configured the same on every one of my devices and there is no easy way to make them match.
3. The way reply works is determined by how the group owner set replies to work. Reply can turn into "Reply All".
4. You want to make sure you click the "reply to group" or "reply to sender" if they are offered in your email program and that is what you want to do.
5. You MUST reply from the same email address that you use for groups.io. For example, I use [wb4ehg@rjoerger.com](mailto:wb4ehg@rjoerger.com) as my DCARC email but if I reply from [rich@rjoerger.com](mailto:rich@rjoerger.com) or [pepper@rjoerger.com](mailto:pepper@rjoerger.com) that reply is rejected. (I use email addresses as a way to filter my email, they all go to the same email account).
6. Do not change the subject line when you reply.

7. At the bottom of the emails there are some choices which you can click to take the action you want. Below is a screen capture from an email I received. **This may be your safest way to reply.** But still make sure the reply message shows your email (the one you use for DCARC) as the sender!
