- Preparations for Field Day food budget?:
  - Motion to approve \$300 passed this meeting.
- Use / Disposal of donated equipment by Claude Fore KF5VOS
  - Claude donated a lot of good gear from his father's estate.
    - He asked that we give him a list of the equipment and its estimated worth
      - Per Fred: legally we cannot give him those values
    - We need to make an inventory and:
      - Decide what we want to keep for club use
      - What we want to sell and what a fair price is.
        - ✓ We will set a fair price for the item and offer it to club members (the method of determining fair price TBD)
        - ✓ The first member to respond gets the item.
        - ✓ After TBD date we will accept offers on the items not sold and accept the highest offer after **TBD** amount of time
- Tom made a motion to activate the club station Sat & Sun July 5 & 6 to work the <u>13 Colonies event</u>.





- Motion passed unanimously
- There was a discussion about allowing a small number of members to operate using the club call from home on other days.
  - Discussion is still ongoing. NOTE: Everyone operating with the club call needs Tom's (N4MEO) express permission! As trustee, the FCC holds Tom responsible for the use of the call.
    - a statewide QSO party where each station within a state uses the same call sign (assigned to the state for this event). Logs between the stations with in the state are not synchronized, there is no prohibition against working the same call sign (could be a physically different station) on the same band and mode more than once. There are times when there will be two stations with the same call sign operating the same mode on the same band. You can work both of them. WB4EHG has done this many times with no mention of the contact being a dup. {EHG: my philosophy is to work each state more than once on each of the 3 modes: phone, CW, digital. This guarantees that my call will make it into at least one of the logs for each state. I actively search for the state+mode I have not worked yet} Note that n1mm+ has a log for 13 Colonies, I have not tried it yet, interesting to see if it has a problem with dups.}
- The Internet connectivity at the station has been improved thanks to Jeff WB3ISP and Tony W6TNY
  - Tony installed Ethernet switches and custom made Ethernet cables in the trailer and in the building at the station.
